

History of Outreach Alaska Projects Specific to SHS

2003 – 2007

Reported to the SHS Board of Trustees May 18, 2013

2003 – Coordinated “**SHS Linens project**” to replace all linens at the seminary inclusive of Bathroom Linens, bed linens for all apartments and all beds, blankets, - all sizes from a list of needs request from Bishop Benjamin, then Dean of the Seminary. Lower 48 churches raised funds and purchased items shipped to SHS. Balance of list was coordinated at a discounted cost for payment/pickup in Kodiak at the Wal-Mart. **All items purchased, shipping costs, and fundraising coordinated by Outreach Alaska**

2004 - Coat Racks – all new coat racks were made at St. Mary Antiochian Orthodox Church, Wichita, KS and shipped to SHS. Funded by Outreach Alaska. **Materials and Shipping costs only – paid by Outreach Alaska**

2004 – Matching Gift from OCMC **\$5,000**

2005 -2007 Library Project – 5 Phases purchased – Books/Titles list, remodeling inclusive of shelving, carpeting, tile; all new furnishings (Tables and Chairs) in the library and classrooms **+\$17,000**

2006 - First Missionaries Scholarship Fund - \$15,000

2006 – At the request of Fr. Chad Hatfield, Outreach Alaska established a **Discretionary Fund** for him to be used for SHS expenses. This was to be provided to him \$1,000 at a time. **\$2,000**

2006 – Completely funded all remodeling inclusive of painting, flooring, shelving, refrigeration and food purchases to establish the **St. Julianna Food Pantry** for the seminary students and their children. This was from a room selected by the staff to be used for this project. **\$5,000**

2007 – Partnered with IOCC to sponsor the **RADACT** Substance Abuse Training Program for SHS Seminarians. 3 week course paid for instructors, books, etc. **\$11,000.**
